

How to participate:

4. Return your completed log to the library and your child will receive a small prize!
5. Repeat steps 2-4

Early learning is educational programming outside the home for children between birth and 5 years old. It is a high-quality daycare experience. It's not just babysitting. It's an interactive experience for the child which includes stimulating activities such as reading, singing, talking and playing.

Read books and encourage your child to read with you.

WAYS TO READ WITH YOUR CHILD:

1. Sign your little up to receive a **FREE** book monthly from the Imagination Library by scanning the QR code!

2. Join **1,000 books before kindergarten** at the **Rushville Public Library!**

The concept is simple, the rewards are priceless. Read a book (any book) to your newborn, infant, and/or toddler. The goal is to have read 1,000 books (yes you can repeat books) before your precious one starts kindergarten. Does it sound hard? Not really if you think about it. **If you read just 1 book a night, you will have read about 365 books in a year.** That is 730 books in two years and 1,095 books in three years. If you consider that most children start kindergarten at around 5 years of age, you have more time than you think!
